How do you know a product's claims are legitimate?

Many products claim to have clinical trials that support their use but either don't show their results, or worse, have not published them in a scientific journal.

Only when clinical results have appeared in a scientific journal, which means they have been independently approved by other experts in the field, can they be considered valid.

The careful consumer should watch for non-supported claims. Clinical results with MXL have appeared in two scientific publications thus far in the [American Journal of Alzheimer's Disease & Other Dementias](#).

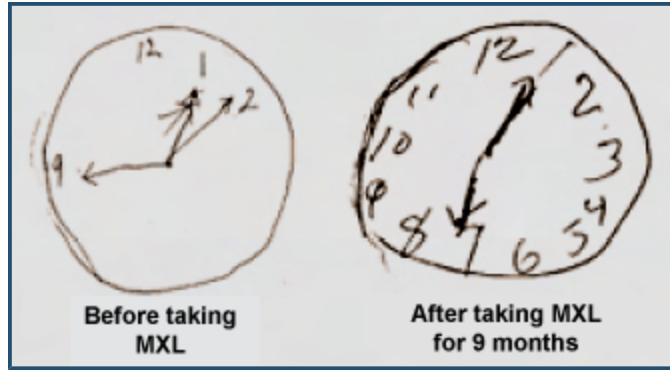
